Camp Impeesa is located on 52 acres of fairly rough wilderness.
This means that wild animals, coy-

otes, skunks, and insects, are a real concern. Coyotes have been regularly spotted in the area. These creatures have been known to attack small children. It is our recommendation that small children are not left unsupervised and should not be using the trails without adult supervision. Depending on the weather, ticks and mosquitoes may or may not be a problem. Please use bug spray and do regular tick checks on yourself and friends.

Emotional Support and Service Animals

We have emotional support dogs on site this year. While these animals fall into a grey area according to Ontario Law; we are allowing them this year. These animals must be in the care and control of their owner at all time, (that means no barking, and no jumping up) they must be on a leash no longer than 8 ft; and their owners must clean up after them. Please make it clear to the staff and other attendee that these dogs are integral to your enjoyment of the event and do not impede other peoples ability to enjoy themselves too; especially those that have fear of dogs.

If anyone is having a problem with these rules not being followed, please discuss it with the owner. If you aren't comfortable doing so please come get a staff member and we will accompany you. Failure by owners to abide by these rules will result in you being asked to leave. If anyone has been bitten by these animals the staff needs to know immediately.

Please do not flush paper towels or feminine products down the toilet, Many a backed up toilet has happened and that is not pleasant or fun for anyone.


